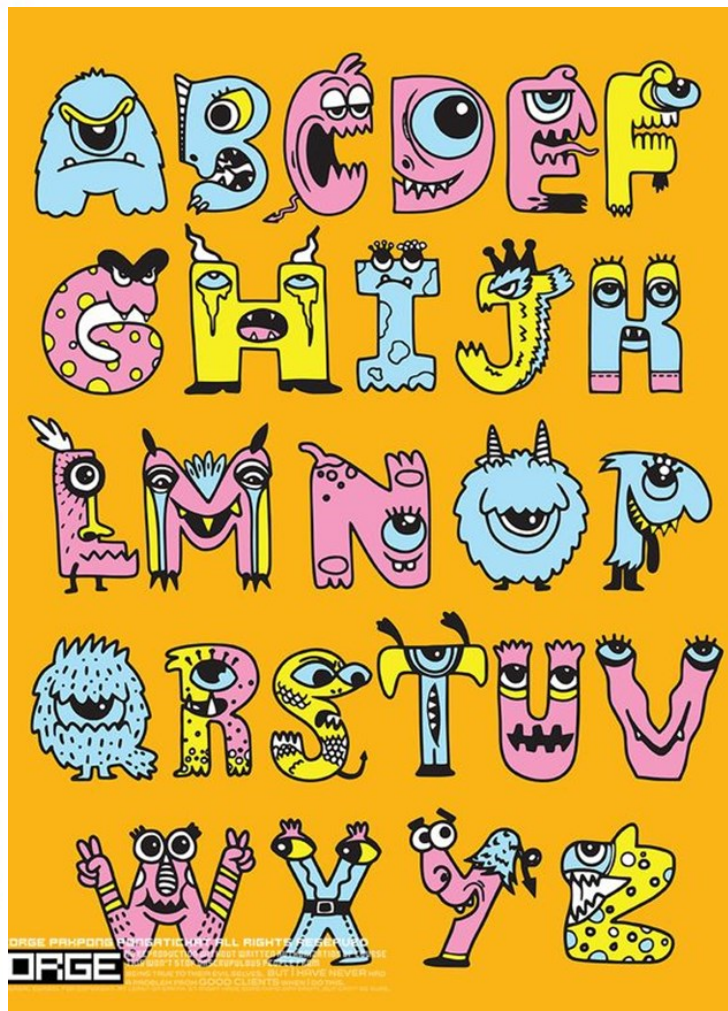
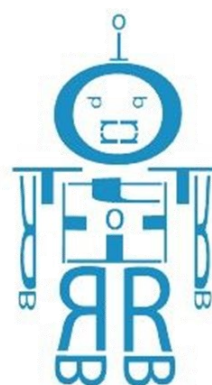

Practice adding the 3D lettering effect on to this alphabet. Use pencil only.

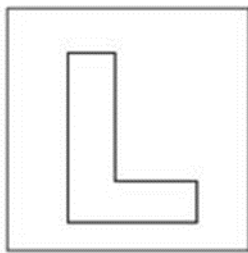

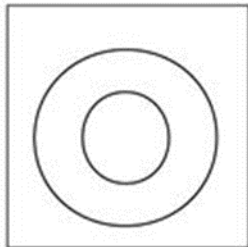

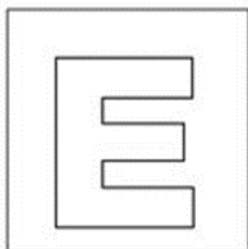
1. Draw a block letter L.

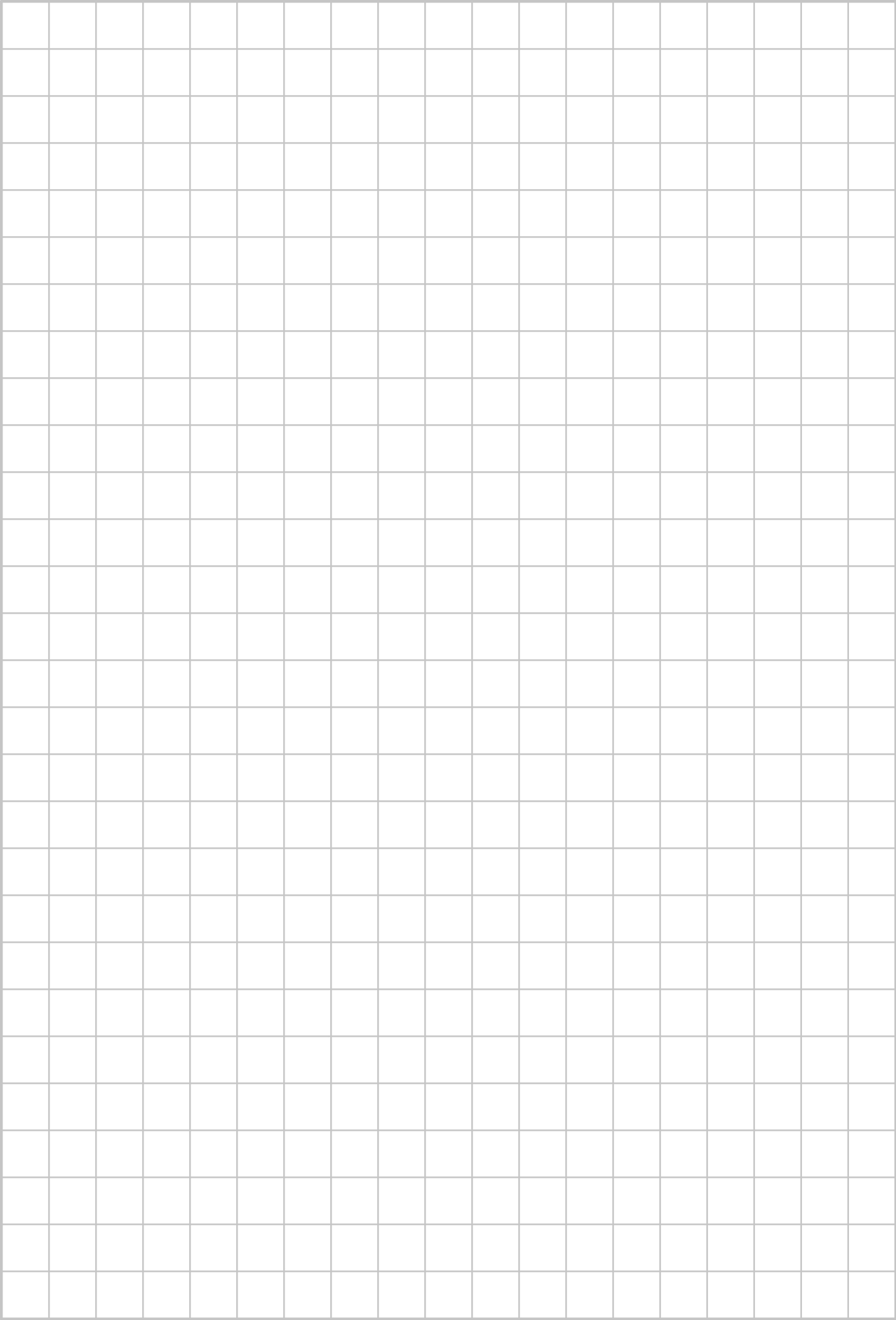

Try adding the 3D effect on to the word Love. In between the two lines above you will be shown how to draw your own block lettered word and how to add a 3D effect on to the letters.

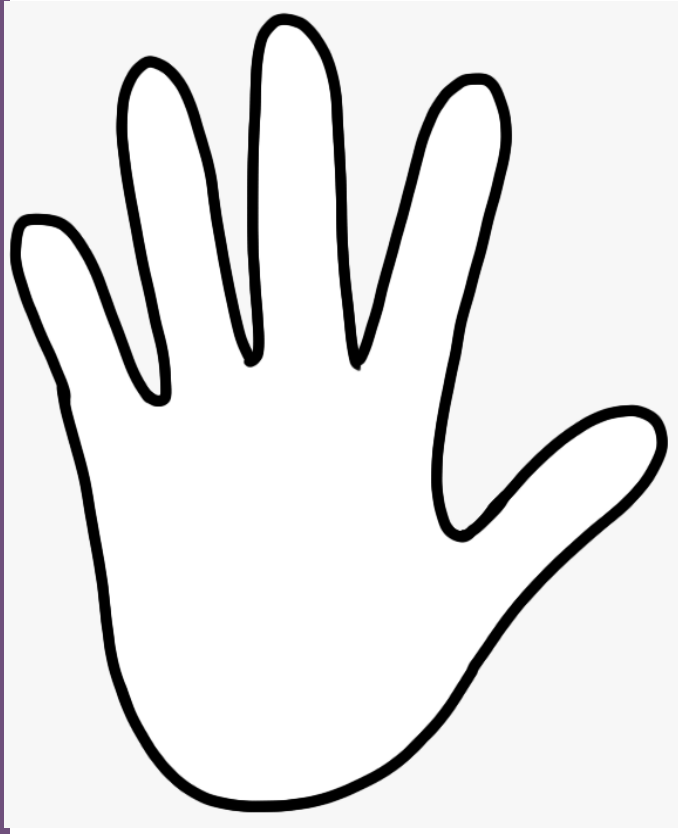

Add text inside the hand on the right. You can either copy the example or be inspired by it and add your own words. The box below is for your own typography example.

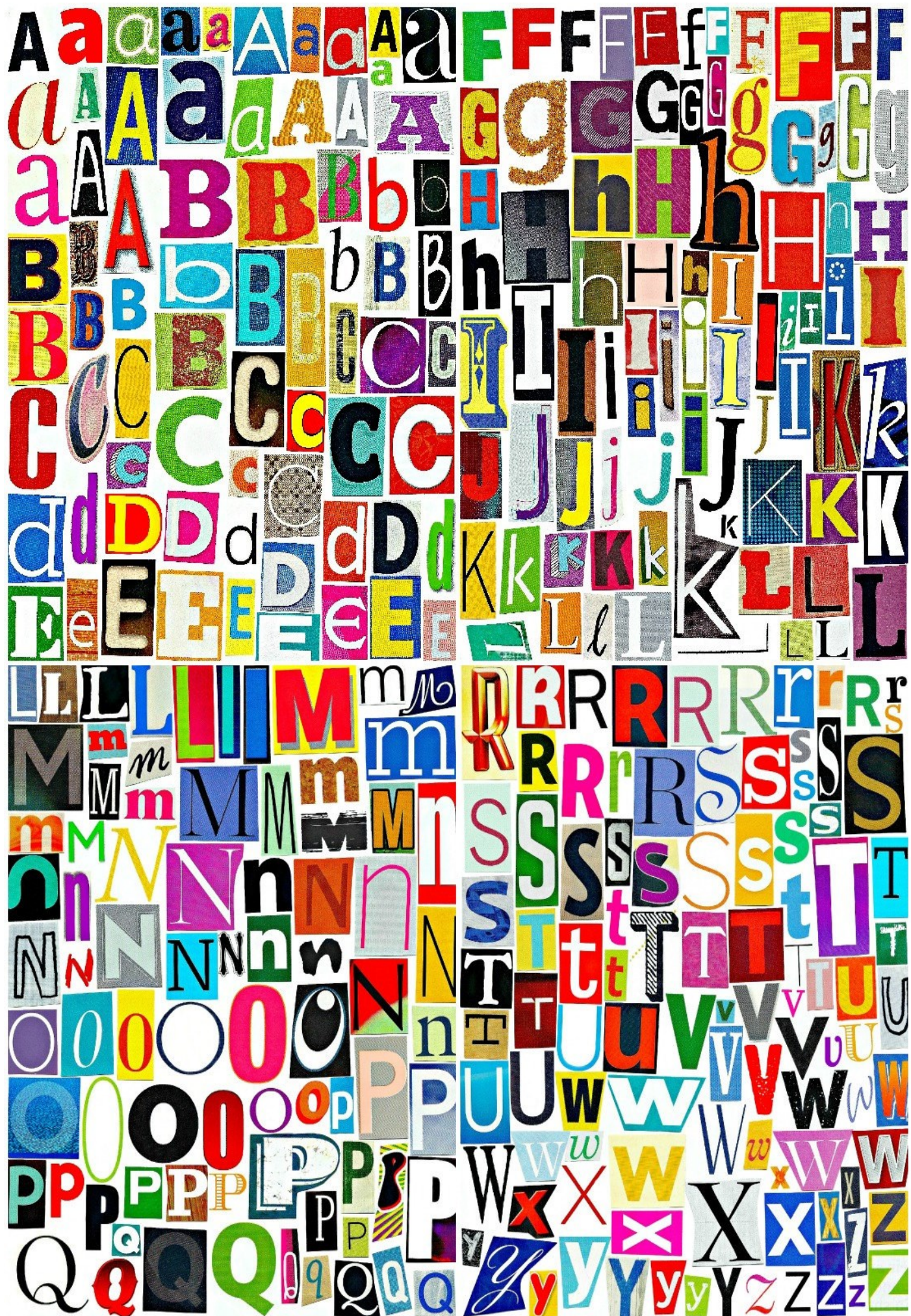


A large empty rectangular box for creating a typography example.

Be creative! Minimum 10 attempts. Add colour once complete.

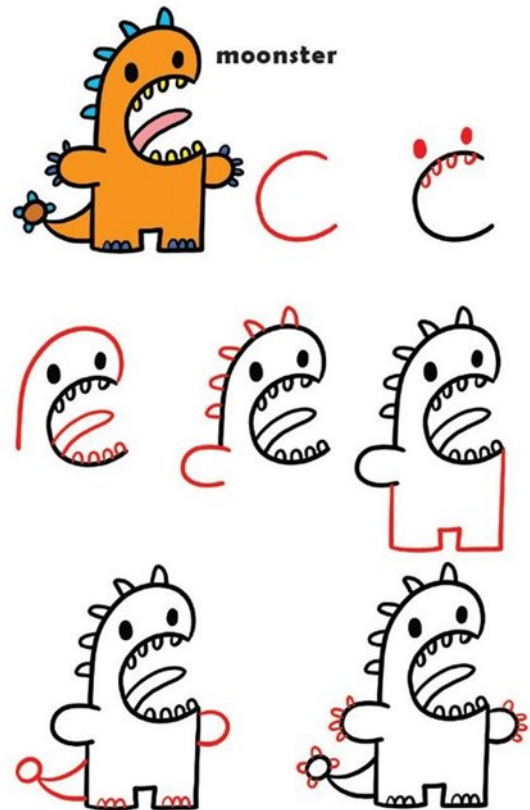
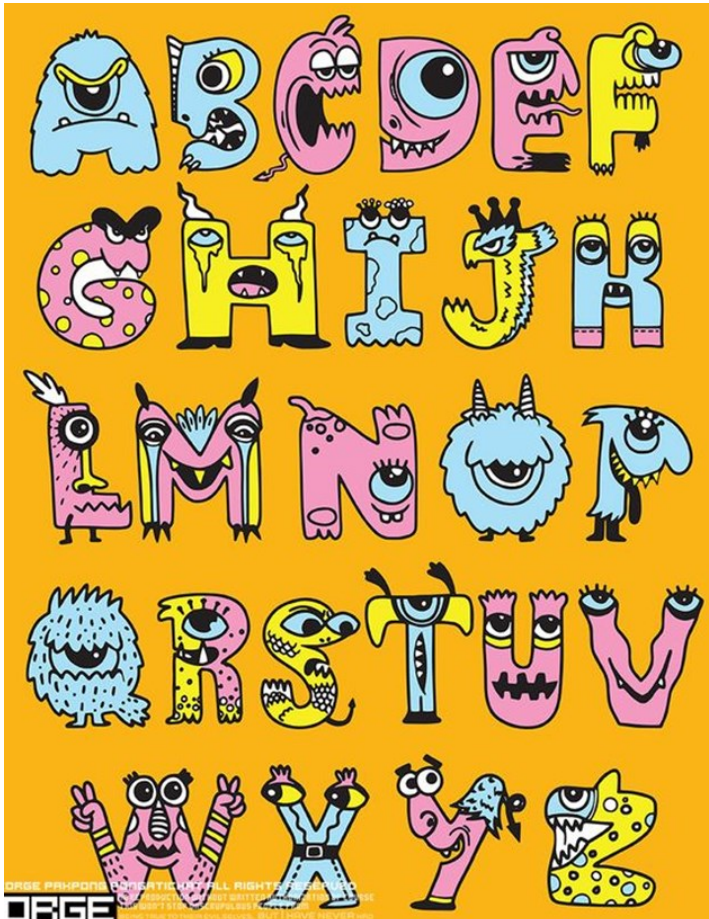


Task 7: Letter monsters

Just like the technique of Anthropomorphism; which is where human features are added to everyday objects, you can also add features on to lettering/ fonts.

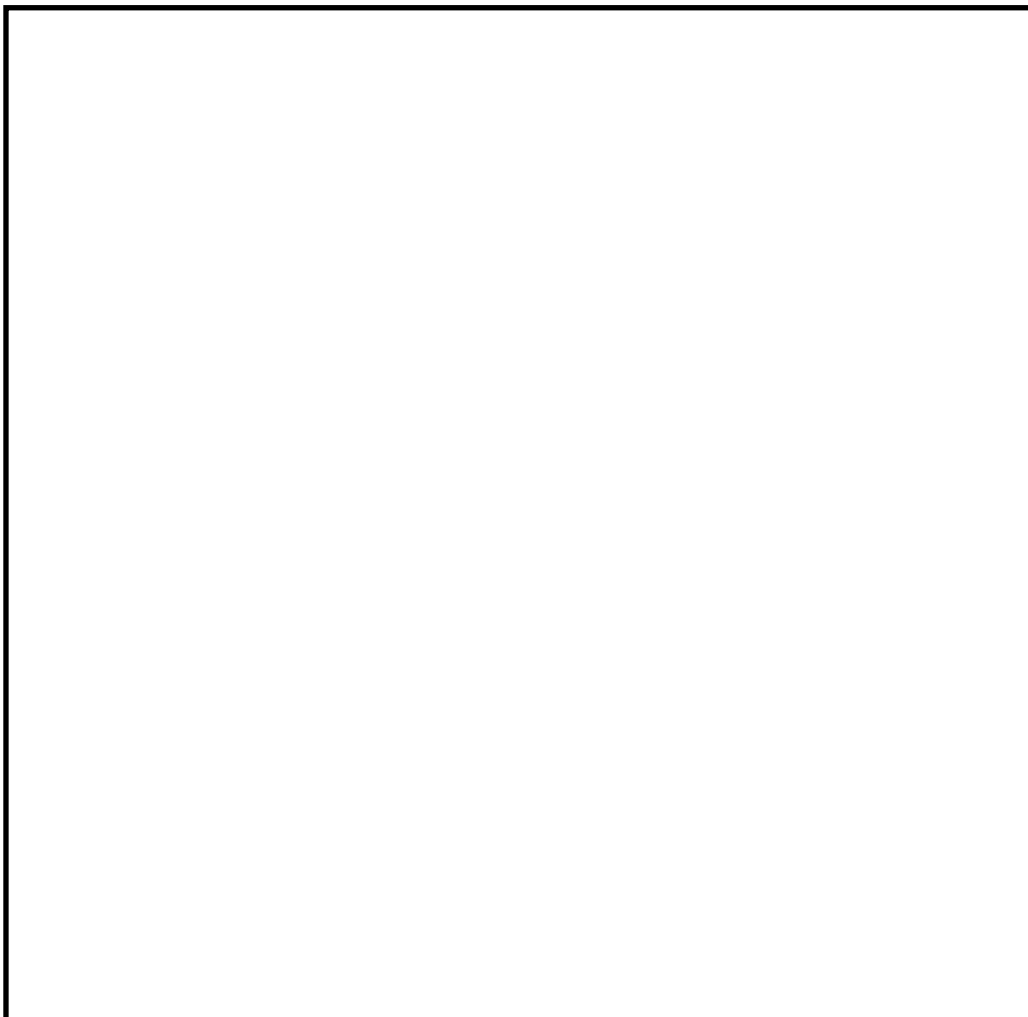
Adding humour, life and ultimately making lettering/ words more memorable.

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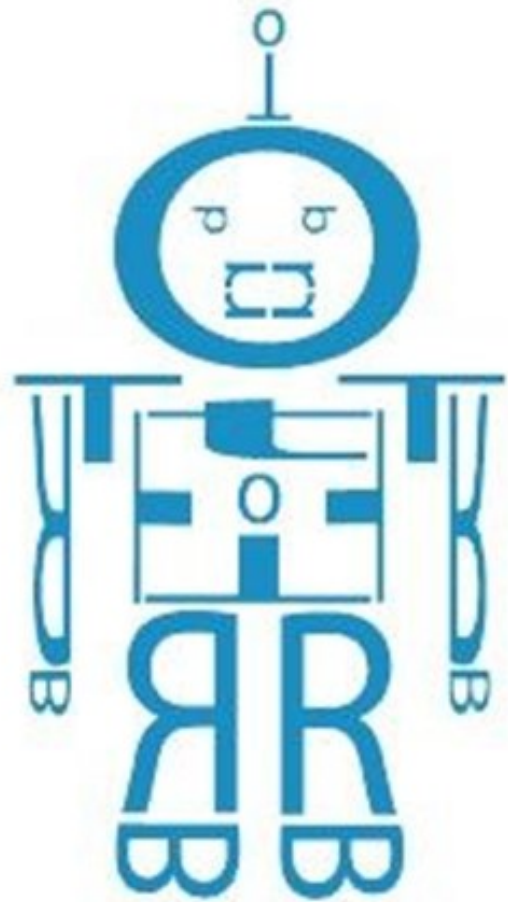
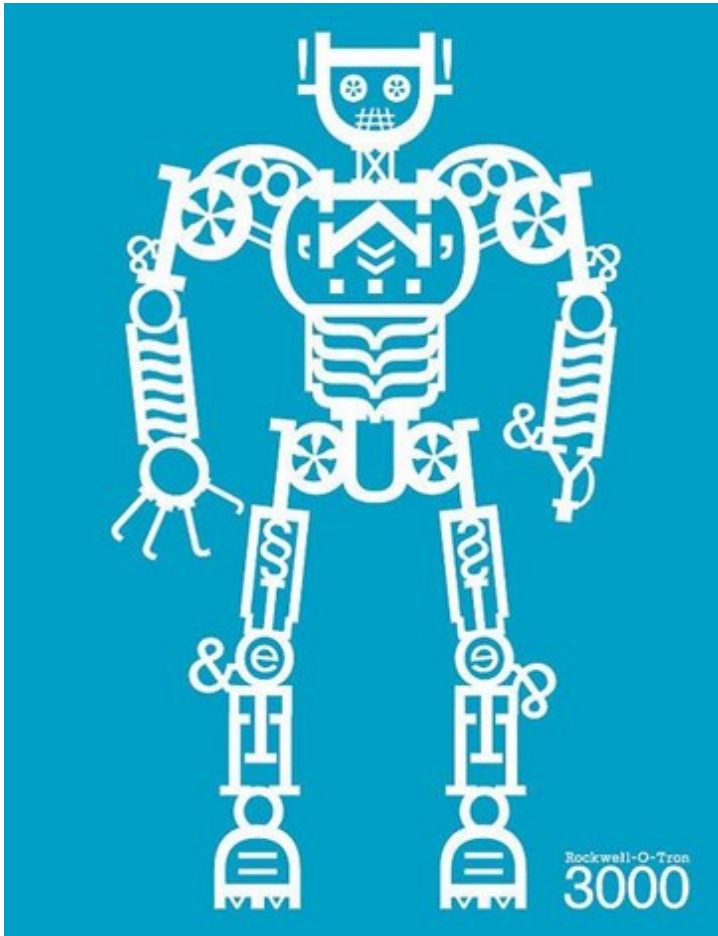


Task 8: Berni Valenta
